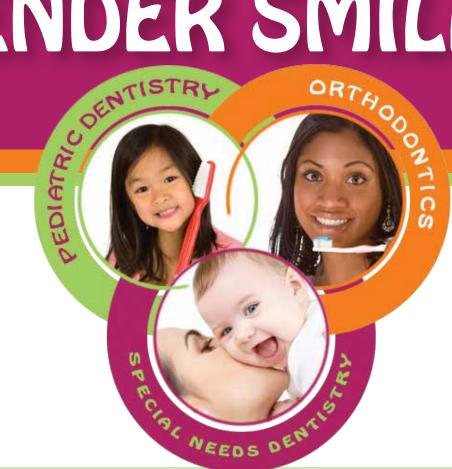





# The Logic of Logos and Catchphrases CLOSE BUT NO CIGAR

Did you ever wonder where the origin of this popular idiom "Close but no Cigar" came from? By definition, it means "to fall short of a successful outcome" or "close call." It was first coined in the United States in the late 19th or early 20th century.

While it can't be proven definitively, it's likely that the phrase originated at fairgrounds around this time. Much like fairs today, booths would be set up and fair workers would host overpriced, nearly-impossible-to-win games for happy fairgoers to try. Games of strength, accuracy, and skill were played by men and women, and occasionally, someone would win just enough to keep people interested. Back then, though, the prizes weren't typically for kids, but for mom and dad, and during that time cigars were a very common prize given out to winners. Now-a-days the prize cigar has given way to big stuffed animals and plastic guitars hanging from the rafters of the game booths.

Because of this, most etymologists think it likely that the phrase originated from when someone came close to winning one of the nearly impossible games, but ultimately lost, earning "no cigar," with game workers belting the phrase out when people lost, trying to draw crowds and encourage the person who got close to try again. As these fairs traveled around from town to town, state to state, the phrase spread rapidly.



Today the phrase is still as popular as it was yesteryear. How many times have you found yourself saying this in your lifetime? I would wager, at least once.

# Where Did Man's Best Friend First Appear?

The earliest known dog-like fossils come from Europe. However, some DNA studies have implicated east Asia and the Middle East. A new and large DNA study is lining up with the fossils, suggesting dogs originated in Europe some 19,000 to 32,000 years ago.

Most scientists agree that dogs emerged from wolves to become the first domesticated animal. Their wolf ancestors began to associate and interact with people with theories such as: maybe they were drawn to and met humans by food in garbage areas left by human hunters. In the process of first human interactions they became tamer, and scientists believe people found them useful for things like hunting and guard duty. Over a very long time in this human environment, wolves gradually turned into the first dogs.

Researchers gathered DNA from fossils of 18 ancient wolf-like and dog-like creatures that lived up to 36,000 years ago in Argentina, Belgium, Germany, Russia, Switzerland and the United States. They compared the genetic material to modern samples from 49 wolves from North America, Asia, Europe and the Middle East with 77 dogs of a wide variety of breeds including cocker spaniel, basenji and golden retriever. Thru this study there now is genetic evidence for the origin of dogs coming from wolves and that the kind of wolf that gave rise to dogs is now extinct.

Many studies also suggest a better case for Europe than for east Asia or the Middle East as the only place where dogs emerged. Scientists conclude that Europe played a major role in the domestication process but cannot argue doubts that Asia and the Middle East may also have had ancient wolf like creatures as well.





Historical Williamsburg

Williamsburg was founded in 1632 as Middle Plantation, a fortified settlement on high ground between the James and York Rivers. The city served as the capital of the Colony and Commonwealth of Virginia from 1699 to 1780 and was the center of political events in Virginia leading to the American Revolution. The College of William & Mary, established in 1693, is the second-oldest institution of higher education in the United States and the only one of the nine colonial colleges located in the South; its alumni include three U.S. presidents as well as many other important figures in the nation's early history. Modern Williamsburg is a college town, inhabited in large part by William & Mary students and staff.

The city's tourism-based economy is driven by its heart, Colonial Williamsburg, the restored historic area of the city. There you can find in the historic district a living history museum where actors in period costume depict daily Colonial life in the streets, stores and workshops. Along with nearby Jamestown and Yorktown, Williamsburg forms part of the Historic Triangle, which attracts more than four million tourists each year.

Come springtime, Williamsburg is alive with life, music, and entertainment. Greater Williamsburg offers wild rides, fun and adventure throughout, shopping and fine dining on River Walk Landing, living history museums, sailing on the York River, hiking and biking throughout the many parks and trails in the area and more. There is so much to see and do in Williamsburg, you might need a few days to experience the many different cultural and historical places to go and visit. Here is only a partial list of some of the Williamsburg attractions.

Busch Gardens has always been a big draw for tourists. The theme park is bright and clean and caters to the family. In April it is especially beautiful with its fresh tulips and spring flowers that are abundant throughout the park. The park has many attractions, cool rides and roller coasters, and everything else a theme park has to offer. You can even take a tour to the Anheuser Busch Facility for free beer samples.

Colonial Williamsburg- Walk the old town and talk to the guides who are dressed in period clothing. They will tell you all about the history of the area and the people back in the day. The old buildings are a site to see. There is even a ghost tour at night.

College of William and Mary- The Sir Christopher Wren Building is only one of several historical attractions on the campus. The Wren Building is the oldest College building in America. The College is the second oldest University in the U.S.







## Stars Challenge Summer Camp at MAST

MAST, the Marine Academy of Science and Technology, is once again hosting a Stars Challenge weeklong summer camp in marine science for middle school students. Deadline for applications is June 16, and applications can be found on line at www.starschallenge.org.

The program is a handson course with both lab and field work that explores the marine life and habitats of Sandy Hook's beaches and estuaries. The oneweek camp runs from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. Monday through Friday and is open to students who have completed 6th, 7th or 8th grade classes and earned a "B" or higher in their current year's science course.



Identical sessions will be offered June 25-29, July 9-13, July 16-20 and July 23-July 27 for the convenience of interested students.

During the weeklong program, students will explore marine life by collecting, identifying and dissecting marine plants and animals, as well as learning to identify the unique characteristics of the various marine habitats on Sandy Hook including beaches, salt marshes, estuaries, bay and ocean. Students will be taught to understand physical impacts of the waves, tides and currents on the beach. Chemistry courses will also be offered, giving students the opportunity to experiment with techniques to analyze water temperature, dissolved oxygen content, and other chemicals in the water.

The summer Program is currently administered by The Stars Challenge and Hosted by MAST. The Stars Challenge is a science enrichment program with a goal towards encouraging more students to become innovators involved in science and technology to prepare them to take the lead in future technology. Focus is on students working in small groups to create innovative solutions. It was founded by Dr. Steve Chappell and Margaret Ann Chappell and offers fall and winter courses as well as summer programs in other schools in addition to the MAST program.

John Valente, MAST physics instructor, is the lead teacher for the program. He will be joined by three more MAST instructors, each teaching one of the week of the summer program. Teachers instructing with Valente this year are chemistry instructor Jessica Godkin, biology instructor Clare Ng, and oceanography instructor Lisa Baskin.

Valente said in past years students have always been eager to do both the lab and field work in the program, especially "the dissections of the major animal groups that are studied. They like that the program is a serious investigation of the marine environment since the course emphases the reasons why specific field investigations or dissections are conducted." Another unique area of study is the Holly Forest located on Sandy Hook. Marine Holly Forests are rare along the eastern seaboard, "having one right in our own backyard! is very special" Valente said.

Acceptance into the program is limited to 18 students per class, with two classes offered each of the four weeks. Students bring their own lunches. Cost for the programs is \$300. The on-line application, along with more information, can be found at www.starschallenge.org.

# THE MITZVAH PROJECT:

# What Every Upcoming Bar/Bat Mitzvah Needs to Know

A mitzvah project is one way to make sure your bar/bat mitzvah is unique and special. You'll choose one mitzvah, become an expert in it, and then present it to your friends and family in a way that only you can. Your bat mitzvah project is of the most meaningful things you can do in honor of your bar/bat mitzvah.

#### Here's how it works:

#### 1. Choose a Mitzvah

That's not as easy as it sounds because there are hundreds to choose from! The good news is that, since there are so many, you should be able to find one that's meaningful and interesting to you. Start by thinking about your strengths and talents. Are you detail oriented? Artistic? Good at math or science? Love cooking? There are mitzvahs that have to do with every area of life.

#### All mitzvahs fall into two basic categories:

- Mitzvahs between you and G-d. Shabbat, keeping kosher and prayer are examples of mitzvahs between man and G-d. G-d commands us to do them, and they don't directly involve those around us.
- Mitzvahs between you and others. Charity, loving your fellow as yourself and the prohibitions against murder, stealing etc. are all examples of this kind of mitzvah. G-d commands us to do them, but they directly involve those around us.

#### 2. Find out everything you can about this Mitzvah.

Start by making sure you know exactly how to do the mitzvah correctly. Once you've got it down pat, learn about what it means, and why it plays an important part in Judaism. Ask your rabbi to suggest books or other resources you can use.

#### 3. You've done your research, now it's time to make this mitzvah your own.

Read over all your notes and highlight things that you found inspirational or meaningful. Think about how you would like to express this meaning and inspiration. It can be a scrapbook, a charity project, a computer program or a song. How you structure your mitzvah project depends on your own interests and talents and is entirely up to you. But the most important part of making this mitzvah your own is that you make a resolution to DIY--do it yourself!--whenever the opportunity arises. Since you're now an expert in this mitzvah, it shouldn't be a hard promise to keep. Let your imagination go – as long as you are determined and realistic you can choose almost anything for your mitzvah project.

Although you'll become a bat mitzvah with or without a Mitzvah Project, we encourage you to try it – it's a wonderful way to enter Jewish adulthood. And, chances are, the experience will stick with you long after your bat mitzvah celebration is officially over.







# Enjoy a long retirement with multiple income streams

Increasing longevity is a practical reason you may want to develop an income plan to cover your expenses. To help you enjoy a long and comfortable retirement, using many different types of income streams can help balance your need for both growth and income while providing options to help minimize taxes throughout your retirement.

**Retirement accounts** — Your IRA and your employer-sponsored retirement plan, such as a 401(k), can be essential sources of retirement income. Distributions from a traditional IRA or employer-sponsored plan are taxable, and distributions from a Roth IRA or employer-sponsored plan are tax-free. Bond mutual funds and exchange-traded funds also provide interest income.

**Sale or conversion of investment assets** — Once you reach age 70½, you will need to take required minimum distributions from your 401(k) and your traditional IRA. But you may need to sell investments outside these accounts as well, or at least convert some investments into income-producing vehicles. Be aware of the tax consequences, however.

**Social Security benefits** — Although the rules have recently changed, the best way to maximize Social Security benefits may still be to wait as long as possible before taking benefits, especially for the higher-earning spouse. You can start receiving benefits at age 62; however, benefits received before your "full" retirement age (currently age 66 or 67) will be permanently reduced. If you delay taking benefits past full retirement age, the amount you receive will increase every year until age 70.

**Annuity income** — Annuities are insurance company products that may help assure a predictable lifetime income. Similar to creating a "personal pension," they come in a variety of forms and can provide a guaranteed income stream for as long as you live, no matter what happens in the markets. Read the prospectus carefully to understand the objectives, risks, charges and expenses before investing in an annuity.

**Reverse mortgage equity** — While a reverse mortgage is not suitable for everyone, for those needing to tap the equity in their homes, it can be something to think about. A reverse mortgage can either provide you with additional regular income payments or be used as a strategy during down markets when withdrawals from your portfolio may be unfavorable.

By taking full advantage of these sources of income, you can go a long way toward enjoying the retirement you have envisioned. So plan ahead, learn all your options and make those choices that are right for you.

# **DO YOU NEED A LAWYER IN MUNICIPAL COURT?**

As indicated on our website, there are numerous charges that are heard in the Municipal Courts in the State of New Jersey. These range from low level motor vehicle violations such as going through a stop sign, careless driving, failure to maintain your lane and other charges that generally carry very low fines and two or less motor vehicle points. If you have been charged with any motor vehicle violation that carries more than two motor vehicle points upon a conviction, we suggest that you obtain the advice of counsel before going to court. The purpose of this article is to provide the reader with some information as to whether or not they need legal representation in Municipal Court on a low-level motor vehicle violation that carries two or less motor vehicle points.

As most citizens of New Jersey know, municipal prosecutors will, generally, as a matter of course offer a "no point" or "zero point" violation as part of a plea bargain if you are charged with one of these low-level motor vehicle violations. The monetary cost of these "no point" or "zero point" violations are rather excessive in that you are required to pay a \$250.00 surcharge for this "privilege." The statute which provides this "no point" plea is called the unsafe driving statute. The basic theory in accepting a "no point" or "zero point" plea bargain is to potentially avoid motor vehicle points on your license in order to keep your auto insurance premiums lower and, potentially, to avoid the suspension of your driving privileges where you are in danger of accumulating 12 motor vehicle points which will result in a temporary suspension of driving privileges.

However, it should be pointed out that there are a number of situations in which your acceptance of such a "no point" or "zero point" plea bargain may adversely affect your rights without your knowledge. One such situation is where you have already previously pled guilty to unsafe driving on more than one occasion. Your third guilty plea to unsafe driving within a certain period of time will subject you to four motor vehicle points when you may be under the mistaken belief that you will not be receiving any motor vehicle points. Another such situation where you potentially will need legal representation is where the low-level motor vehicle violation is the result of a motor vehicle accident.

The bottom line is that, regardless of what type of motor vehicle violation you are charged with, you should seek the advice of an attorney before appearing in Municipal Court by yourself and entering into a plea bargain which may subject you to other legal ramifications of which you were not

Typically, when we receive a call for a motor vehicle violation, we initially attempt to obtain as much information as possible from the potential client to determine whether or not they will require legal representation given their individual circumstances.



Highlighters are essential when wanting that goddess like glow, and this trick will leave you with a long lasting highlighter, even when it breaks. It is a bit similar to the eyeshadow fixing process. First gather up all the fragments into the original container and crush all the fragments together. Add a few drops of rubbing alcohol to the container and wait for it to soak. Using either your finger or the back of a spoon, rub and smooth down the makeup. It should be perfectly new!

#### Lipstick

Breaking a new lipstick is definitely one of the most stressful things for beauty gurus. First, twist the lipstick until everything that is left is exposed. Use a Q-tip to clean the base of the lipstick so the base is nice and smooth for the broken piece. Next, use a lighter to carefully heat the base of the lipstick until it is soft. Next, just for a second, light the base of the lipstick, but make sure not to burn yourself while doing this. Take out the Q-tip again and smooth the bottom of the piece so it can sit on the base better. Quickly light the broken piece again so it is warmed up and stick it on the base. Take the lighter and melt the pieces together, and then smooth out the whole lipstick. Put the lipstick in the fridge and let it cool. It is now 100% new!



# **Alzheimer's Can Steal Ability to Know Loved Ones' Faces**

Loss of visual perception may occur early in course of disease, researchers say.

According to Healthday news and Healthfinder.gov, a new study sheds light on what is often called one of the cruelest effects of Alzheimer's disease -- the patient's inability to recognize loved ones.

Researchers report that along with causing memory loss, Alzheimer's also seems to affect people's visual perception -- specifically their ability to recognize faces.

The investigators tested a group of seniors with Alzheimer's, and a "control" group without the brain disease, to see how well they could perceive faces and cars in photos. The pictures were shown either upright or upside down.

"The results for people with Alzheimer's were similar to those in the control group in terms of answer accuracy and the time to process the upside-down faces and cars," study author Sven Joubert, from the University of Montreal, said in a school news release.

"To perform these tasks, the brain must perform a local analysis of the various image components perceived by the eye. However, with the upright faces, people with Alzheimer's were much slower and made more mistakes than the healthy individuals," Joubert explained.

These findings suggest "that Alzheimer's leads to visual perception problems specifically with faces," Joubert said.

The researchers were also surprised to find that this visual impairment occurs in the early stages of the disease.

The study could help family members of Alzheimer's patients better understand their loved one's inability to recognize them and may lead to new ways to delay this problem, the study authors said.

For example, because impaired facial recognition may be due to a visual perception problem -- and not a general memory problem -- strategies such as voice recognition might help Alzheimer's patients recognize loved ones for a longer time period, the researchers said.





Super Grain Quinoa Tacos

Did you know that quinoa is one of the most protein-rich foods we can eat?

### **INGREDIENTS**

- 1 cup quinoa, rinsed
- 1 ½ cup water, or vegetable broth
- 1 ¼ cup salsa
- 1 tablespoon cumin
- 15 oz black bean, 1 can, drained and rinsed
- 1 cup frozen corn, defrosted
- 1 salt, to taste
- 1 olive oil, to taste
- 1 avocado, mashed
- 1 clove garlic, minced
- 2 teaspoons lemon juice
- 3 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 salt, to taste
- 1 pepper, to taste
- 4 tablespoons water
- 1 tortilla, to serve, optional

#### **PREPARATION**

- 1. In a medium saucepan, combine quinoa and water, and bring to a boil over high heat. Reduce heat to low, cover with a lid, and simmer for 10 minutes.
- 2. Add in salsa and cumin, and cover for 5 more minutes or until quinoa is fluffy.
- 3. Add in black beans, corn, salt, and olive oil, and stir until combined.
- 4. For the avocado dressing, combine avocado, garlic, lemon juice, olive oil, salt, and pepper in liquid measuring cup and whisk until smooth.
- 5. Whisk in water a little bit at a time until desired consistency is reached. 6. For extra smooth consistency, process all ingredients in blender or food processor.
- 6. Portion out into 4 containers and refrigerate for up to 5 days.
- 7. Enjoy!





## **QUESTION:**

aginal dryness is extremely common during menopause. It's just one of a collection of symptoms known as the genitourinary syndrome of menopause (GSM) that involves changes to the vulvovaginal area, as well as to the urethra and bladder. # Blue Light Blockers

Sunlight contains several different color light rays, each that affects us differently. These shades are characterized by their energy and wavelength; light rays that have relatively long wavelengths contain less energy, and those with short wavelengths have more energy. Blue light rays have the shortest wavelengths, therefore, the highest amount of energy.

The display screens of computers, electronic notebooks, smartphones and other digital devices radiate only half the amount of blue light as the sun does; but because of the time using these devices and the proximity of the screens, it has become a higher risk for long-term eye health effects. The cornea and lens of the eye, are blockers of UV rays reaching the retina but blue light passes through, becoming a cause of serious damage and/or possible vision loss.

In the US, 97% of kids under the age of four use mobile devices. 77% of Americans have smart phones and teenagers spend an approximate 6.5 hours a day staring at a screen. With these statistics being so high, it is established that Americans have a high exposure to blue light. Because of this, it is important to be aware of certain blue light filters that can protect your retina. Fortunately, there has been several productions of blockers that protect your eyes without affecting the visibility of the display screen, some even act as a screen protector from scratches or cracks. 

# All You Need to Know: Stomach Bug

WHAT IS IT: sickness caused by a virus which spreads from person to person or through food contamination. Symptoms usually appear 1-2 days after exposure and are mild, usually lasting 1-2 days.

#### **SYMPTOMS**

- Upset Stomach
- Diarrhea
- Vomiting
- Fever
- Headache
- Abdominal cramps
- Dehydration

#### **TREATMENT**

- Get plenty of rest.
- Wait about 30-60 minutes after the last vomiting to try drinking fluids.
- Sip small amounts of clear liquids frequently. Try ice chips, sips of water, flat ginger ale or 7-up, weak tea, diluted apple juice, Gatorade, clear soups, Jell-O, popsicles.
- Eat small amounts of bland food frequently for 2-3 days to prevent recurrence.
- Let your gastrointestinal tract settle by not eating for several hours. Then start with small amounts of bland, easy-to-digest food such as cooked cereals, bread or bagel (no butter or margarine), toast with jelly, crackers, plain pasta, pretzels or bread sticks, fruits (banana, apple, applesauce), cooked potatoes, cooked vegetables, eggs, rice, chicken, turkey, and baked fish.
- Avoid dairy products, greasy or spicy foods, raw vegetables, caffeine, and alcohol until recovery is complete.

#### WHEN TO SEEK CARE

- Stools containing blood or black stools
- Temperature over 101.5F for more than 24 hours
- Prolonged vomiting
- Signs of dehydration
- Diarrhea that lasts more than 3 days

#### **PREVENTION**

- Wash your hands.
- Don't share drinks.
- Do not prepare food for people if you are sick.
- Throw out refrigerated leftovers once a week to avoid eating spoiled food
- Clean surfaces well before preparing food on them.
- Keep your meats separate from your vegetables when storing them.
- Cook meat to 160F and maintain at 140F or higher.
- Thaw meat in the refrigerator or microwave.
- Refrigerate leftovers within two hours.
- Don't put cooked meat on the plate where raw meat was held

# Travel with Your Resistance Band 4 Strength Training Exercises You Can Do Anywhere

#### How it works:

Do this circuit 3 times without resting between exercises (only resting at end of circuit).

#### 1. Single-Leg Step-Ups

Reps: 10-15 on each leg

Stand facing a step. Place one foot on the step and the other on the floor. With your abs braced and glutes squeezed, start the movement by pushing through the front foot on the step, driving powerfully upward to the standing position. Lower your body under control. Pause briefly at the bottom and repeat. Complete 10-15 reps on each side.

#### 2. Reverse Lunge

Reps: 10-15 on each leg

Stand with feet together, place the ball of your left foot on the floor. Slide your left foot back; Right leg will bend at 90-degrees. Slide your left foot up to start position, pulling up with the glute of your right leg. (You should feel this in your glutes and some in your quads of the stationary leg). The sliding leg is just going along for the ride. Complete 10-15 reps on each side.

#### 3. Two-Arm Row

Reps: 15

Keeping your feet shoulder width apart, bend your knees and lean forward until you're at a forty-five-degree angle. Pull your shoulder blades back. Now, use a rowing motion to pull the resistance band toward your stomach then lower your arms down. That's one rep. Complete 15 reps.

#### 4. Planks

Get into plank position with your forearms on the floor and your feet straight back so your body and back and your head is looking straight ahead. Make sure to keep your abs tight and don't allow your hips to sink. Stay in position and breath in and out for a minimum of 60 seconds.





# No Stigma Network A Vision for Survivors!

Shrabanee Shah of Millstone Township is a mother and has been the caregiver of a loved one who has dealt with psychiatric illness since the age of nine. She created the "No Stigma" Support Group with assistance from a good friend when she noticed that there was no appropriate support program available for her child after graduating from high school. To her, it almost seemed as if her child was being pulled into a "giant dark hole."

The support groups that were available did not meet his "young adult" needs. Other young adults seemed to have the same feeling: "We want a support group that is peer run, facilitated by a caregiver who understands where we are coming from and who can bring us back on track when we go off track. We want to be ourselves with our own body language, expressions, ideas, and thoughts, and don't want to be limited in what we can say and how we say it."


Each of the young adults that Shrabanee spoke with had a desire to be independent and to live a healthy and productive life. They were either in school, in vocational training, working, or planning to go back to school. Each was remarkable in his or her own way and intent on being responsible for making his or her own life decisions.

Shrabanee's dream was to create a peer support group for young adults where an "I can" attitude is encouraged and supported. The group would supply support, education, outreach, and advocacy to assist the members in achieving their goals. Shrabanee was approached by three young ladies with similar ideas who suggested the support group be named "No Stigma" since "we are constantly being stamped for our illness and yet all we want is to have a normal life."

The "No Stigma" support group was established on November 4, 2009 as simply a self-help support group for young adults, ages 18 to 30. Six years later, the simple support group became a New Jersey nonprofit corporation, 501(c)(3) tax-exempt organization re-named "No Stigma Network, Inc."

NSN was designed for individuals who are ready to make a positive change in their lives. The group embraces a constructive approach to the concept of "Peer Support", including self-help practices at their meetings such as stress reduction techniques, mindfulness, effective communication and problem solving skills, and a focus on wellness and empowerment.

- Each support group is led by an experienced facilitator who provides structure and guidance to the meetings.
- NSN promotes high standards for young adults with mental health challenges by:
- Encouraging positive health and wellness practices
- Supporting healthy financial responsibility
- Maintaining a young adult support system where members are encouraged to discuss issues in a confidential, safe, and non-judgmental environment.
- Involving members in outreach to the community to increase awareness of mental health challenges, and to inform the public about resources including NSN's programs



In addition to the young adult support group, NSN also offers peer support for those over thirty. Recently NSN developed a support group for parents who are dealing with issues brought on by the mental health challenges of their adult children. The parents seek support, guidance, and information to strengthen their families' ability to successfully cope and thrive with these challenges.

All of NSN's programs and activities are provided to its members free of cost. The facilitators, board members, and other support staff are all unpaid volunteers. NSN welcomes new volunteers (over 18) who are interested in working to further develop and support its programs.



# The Toms River Field of Dreams Mission If you build it, they will come!

Toms River High School North teacher, Christian Kane, was involved in a car accident nearly five years ago. Kane's 7-year-old son, Gavin, suffered a severe brain injury as a result of the accident. Gavin, then 19 months old, was in a car seat in the backseat of Kane's car when the vehicle was rearended by a fully-loaded beer truck. Gavin was hospitalized for two months, paralyzed, and is still undergoing daily therapy today. He speaks through a tablet computer and moves around with the help of a specially designed wheelchair.

Christian is an avid sports fan with an athletic background. His older son was in baseball leagues and other sports. Coming to the realization that Gavin was never going to be able to do anything that his older brother could do, Christian had an idea; an idea that steamrolled into something that would not only benefit his own son's special needs but others too. This idea would soon become his main priority, Project Field of Dreams.

The Toms River Field of Dreams (TRFOD) is a project with a mission to encourage and engage two communities (Monmouth and Ocean Counties), with a focus on those with special needs, in physical and social activity by building a community complex to provide opportunities for all individuals of all ages, all abilities, to engage, explore and socialize together. It is envisioned by parents who understand how important it is for those with special needs to have a place where they can feel

It is here that they will be able to enjoy the basic fundamentals of play on a rubberized baseball field and be able to play nine holes of miniature golf on a wheelchair accessible course. Upon completion of the Park they willhave the use of specially made state of the artplayground, a rubberized basketball court, bocce and shuffleboard, use of a handicap equipped zip line, and a complementary snack shack. There will also be a multi sensory walking path

of all ages, abilities and needs. The TRFOD will provide engaging inter-active areas, events for music and art appreciation, organized leagues for special needs baseball and basketball,

with rehabilitative stations. When the project is finished, it will be opened to all residents of surroundingtowns and counties. It will benefit individuals

as well as quiet spaces for observation, reflection, and reorganizing. After the completion of the complex, the hope is to increase awareness of their special needs community and provide an inclusive environment in which all can play and interact together. "The goal is to level the playing field, to make kids who are not typical feel better for an hour, for a day," Kane stated. He wanted Gavin and other

special needs children to be able to enjoy recreational experiences like other kids, whether it be playing baseball, playing miniature golf or just swinging on a swing. According to Kane, there is no park within an hour of Toms River that offers a place for kids with special needs to play and socialize. The project will be started this summer with a goal to finish the project by 2019.

People like Skip Bariscillo, who heard about the project through a friend, and since lastChristmas Eve, has been advocating to help raise funds for the project. Skip knows what it's like to be handicapped after suffering an accident ten years ago that left him with extensive disabilities. He knows firsthand how it feels to desire to be a part of something that used to be normal for him and now he can't be a part of it because of his physical limitations. Christian's main motivation is to make everyone feel "typical". For Skip, he believes this type of facility is "necessary". He believes Toms River Field of Dreams is "necessary to make everyone feel typical". This facility will allow families to enjoy activities along with their handicapped child or adult and make them feel a part of the whole experience. Skip helps out wholeheartedly with the project because he wants to help Christian make everyone feel "typical".

# Did you know... SALT By Pam Teel

# Did you know that the Romans paid their workers in salt and it was actually the Phoenicians who were first involved in the trade of salt?

The Egyptians also used this mineral in the mummification process. They would use what's called natron, a mineral that contains sodium chloride. Natron would be used to keep mummified remains from decaying. A kind of preservative if you will.

Ancient Greeks referred to salt as a divine substance, and the Romans even used it to pay workers for their services. They called it salarium, which is the original term for the word salary that is used today. The Romans regarded salt as "the spice of the Gods." As well as using salt to conserve food or to add flavor, salt played a part in sacrificial ceremonies too as it was believed the Gods liked their offerings to be seasoned. A number of European cities also owe their prosperity to a roaring salt trade during the Middle Ages.

Salt has even been used in religious rites and ceremonies due to its ability to reform after being dissolved. It's been compared to God's unchanging love.

Salt is a natural mineral that is found within rocks on Earth. Now we're not talking about table salt like you would put in your shaker. But this is the natural element sodium. Deposits may also appear above ground in the form of 'salt mountains,' or could lie deep underground so far that mines have to be dug in order to reach it.

Over long periods of time some of this salt is liquefied by the natural rain and gets carried out to sea through the rivers. Once it reaches this area it will build up into what is known as saltpans. There the sun will bake away the water leaving the salt crystals behind.

Salt Superstitions; just like anything else that has been around for such a long time, salt has formed many superstitions over time. The most common tradition of salt says it bring prosperity. This is why many times people will give it as a gift upon reaching a new year, or when moving into a new home.
