



By speaking with Robert, I developed a better understanding of the specifics behind the foundation and the emotions that accompany being involved in such an empowering cause.

Robert's mother, Frances Jean Nolan Heugle, passed away from colon cancer in March of 2000. Frances spent her life devoting her time to children, so what better way to honor her than an organization dedicated to enhancing the lives of children? Robert, along with his siblings, father and an assemblage of family and friends were determined to carry on her legacy. Their ambition persevered and on her birthday; July 26, 2004, they commenced The Frances Foundation.

In the last 14 years, the organization has grown to approximately 50 trustees. 

The Hearts and Minds of Elementary Students Hard at Work in Millstone

Seven passionate Millstone Township Elementary School students decided to do something to help other children in Puerto Rico after both hurricane Irma and Maria decimated the island. The group consists of three 3rd graders, and four 5th graders.

They are a part of a Destination Imagine Group and they are doing a project called Inside Impact. Inside Impact is a challenge by which they identify a real need in a community and create a project to help fulfill their need. They were very distressed with the damage recently caused by the two hurricanes and they wanted to help its victims. They decided to concentrate their efforts on helping Puerto Rican children on their return to school by sending them school supplies. Knowing that other organizations and charities were helping with food, water and clothing, they focused on helping to get the children much needed supplies so they could have an easier time going back to school.

The seven students have reached out for help from their friends, other children, teachers in the Elementary, Middle & Primary schools, the community, and the Middlesex County Bar Association to request funding for shipping and present written proposals to local school principals and orthodontists. The children meet at present on Tuesday mornings, after school, and once every other Saturday to continue the good work.

The supplies are pouring in and now they are in need of monetary donations to help ship these items. They now officially are a non-profit charity corporation they call KINDNESS 4 KIDS, Inc., and have set up a gofundme account to collect donations for shipping and to purchase other needed items like pens, paper, pencils and backpacks.

The group has managed to collect approximately 10 large boxes of school supplies and have shipped at least 4 boxes so far to a school in a rural area in Puerto Rico. Presently there is a collection box at the Primary School and one at Relentless Fitness in Freehold. Donations can be sent to the Millstone Elementary or Middle School or contact them on facebook for a drop off address. Facebook- look under Kindness 4 kids. The team has been hard at work! They just launched an invasive species online teacher resource kit that you can view at PhragKit4Teachers.weebly.com .The resource kit is part of the project they will be presenting at the Future Problem Solving International Conference in La Crosse Wisconsin in June.

They also just participated in the Millstone Stream Cleanup. Bright and early on Saturday, April 14th, Millstone Township Elementary School's Phearless Phragmites Phighters joined Stony Brook -Millstone Watershed organization members for their annual Stream Clean-Up event. Before the crew launched into their clean-up efforts, the young problem-solvers enthusiastically presented their new environmental resource kit for teachers. The students handed out flyers and shared a printed copy of their eBook, "Cornelius and Betty: A Phragmites Adventure." As the students picked up trash along Perrineville Road, they observed with consternation that many cigarette butts had been tossed in close proximity to dry and flammable Phragmites stalks.

The team was pleased to hear from the Environmental Commission Chairman, Eric Davis, that the EC continues to pursue permits for managing the invasive Phragmites patch across from the Millstone Township First Aid Squad building.

The Phearless Phragmites Phighters are once again heading to the Future Problem Solving International Conference! The conference takes place this year June 6-10 in La Crosse, Wisconsin. The bright team of students in grades 3-6 participate in the Community Problem Solving Division which "encourages students to become agents of change and engages students in their communities." (FPSPI.org website) The Millstone Elementary School's problem solving team has devoted two years to their evolving project, and they earnestly strive to spread awareness and motivate other students throughout New Jersey to act against invasive Phragmites. At the International Conference, the students will enjoy connecting with problem solving students from around the globe, sharing their projects,

being interviewed, collaborating creation of a display showcasing their work, and appreciating sights along the beautiful Mississippi River.

A big shout out goes to all the conscientious students involved in the project. They will be the future guardians of our environment!!!!

Did you know that ...?

There are a lot of members in the animal world that mate for life, and in some cases of monogamous mates, both take care of their offspring. It is true though that if one partner in a monogamous pair dies, most surviving partners will go on to find a new mate. Here are ten animals that prefer, for the most part, being with the same mate!!!!!!!

Beavers - Adult beavers can weigh 40 pounds or more, and they mate for life during their third year. Their babies are called kits, and typically 1 to 4 are born in the spring. Both parents care for their kits, which stay with them for about two years. The yearlings typically help care for the next litter. A beaver colony can consist of six or more individuals, including parents, yearlings, and kits.

Gibbons are the nearest relatives to humans that mate for life. They live in small, stable family groups with a monogamous mated pair and offspring under the age of 7. Gibbon families are territorial and defend their territory with morning songs sung by the breeding pair. Gibbons reach sexual maturity between 6 and 8 years of age. Females give birth to one baby at a time, and mating pairs produce an average of 5 to 6 offspring over their reproductive lifetimes.

Wolves live in packs that are typically family groups including a male and female breeding pair and their offspring of varying ages. Only the breeding pair mates, and has one litter a year. Wolves reach sexual maturity between 2 and 3 years of age, and once the youngsters are ready to mate, most leave their birth pack to start their own pack or join an existing pack.

French angelfish mate for life and fight to defend their territory against other angelfish pairs.

The Shingleback Skink is a heavily armored, blue-tongued lizard that inhabits western and southern Australia. It is mostly monogamous and has known to pair with the same mate for up to 20 years. Shingleback lizards live alone for most of the year, but get together with their partners during breeding season in September and November. In western New South Wales, shinglebacks are often seen crossing roads in pairs, the male following the female.

The Mute Swan typically mates for life, though once in awhile, mates change partners, and swans will find another mate if their partner dies. If a male swan loses his mate and finds a new, younger female, she joins him on his territory. However, if the male mates with an older female, they join up on her territory. If a female swan loses her mate, she typically finds a new, younger mate rather quickly. For the most part they stick together because time spent chasing down a new mate each year would cut into chick making time.

Albatrosses mate for life and if one partner dies, the surviving bird may search for years for a new mate. The albatross can live to be 50 years old. Albatrosses spend time on the ground only to breed, typically in large colonies on remote islands. Mating pairs produce just one egg and take turns caring for it. Young albatrosses learn to fly at from 3 to 10 months, depending on the species. Once aloft, it will be 5 to 10 years before they reach sexual maturity and return to the ground to breed.

Penguins are primarily monogamous; however, some species like the Emperor Penguin are serially monogamous, meaning they partner with one mate for a season rather than for life. Monogamous species include African and Magellanic, Gentoo, and Royal penguins. Both male and female penguins prepare the nest and take care of the chicks.

Barn Owls are usually monogamous and mate for life. After the pair forms, the male keeps the female supplied with food beginning about a month before she starts laying eggs. Female barn owls build simple nests of their own regurgitated pellets. Unlike most birds, owls may use their nest sites for roosting throughout the year and nest sites are often reused from year to year, often by different owls.

Bald Eagles spend winters and migration alone; however, they remain monogamous throughout life with their chosen mate. Bald Eagle pairs build platform nests on the tops of trees and produce offspring each year. If one of the pair dies, the surviving eagle will find a new mate for the next breeding season. Bald eagles typically lay 2 or 3 eggs, which are incubated for about 35 days.

Other monogamous mates include coyotes, golden eagles, condors, pigeons, prions, red tailed hawks, ospreys, prairie voles, and yes, even termites and American black vultures.

Of course just like with humans, there is always the chance of one mate cheating on the other. Lol!



Tackling Testicular Cancer: Win the Game with a Strong Offense By Troy Sukkarieh, MD

It only takes a lump the size of a pea in your testicle to signal something serious.

It's estimated that 8,850 American men will develop testicular cancer this year. It is most frequently diagnosed in men aged 20 to 34. And, like several other cancers, your best defense is a good offense in the form of self-examination.

What are the symptoms of testicular cancer?

The most common symptom is feeling a mass, which is why self-exam is so important for detection. You may feel a mass in your testicle or in the scrotal sac. Additionally, you may notice that a testicle is enlarged, experience pain in one of your testicles, or, in extreme cases, experience weight loss or night sweats or cough up blood.

What are the risk factors?

Unfortunately, testicular cancer develops fairly randomly, although having an undescended testicle may increase your risk for developing cancer in either testicle. If you were born with an undescended testicle, you can decrease your risk by having the testicle brought down surgically.

How do I perform a self-exam?

You should conduct a self-examination of your testicles monthly, so I encourage my patients to do it on the first of the month to make remembering a bit easier. You should begin performing self-exams at age 15. The optimum time is after a bath or shower, when the skin of the scrotum is relaxed.

To perform the exam:

- Hold your penis out of the way and check one testicle at a time
- Hold the testicle between your thumbs and fingers of both hands and roll it gently between your fingers
- Look and feel for any hard lumps or smooth rounded bumps or any change in the size, shape or feel of the testicles

It's normal for one testicle to be slightly larger than the other and for one to hang lower than the other. And, each contains an epididymis, which can feel like a small bump on the upper or middle outer side of the testicle. This is normal.

Once you check your testicles regularly you'll learn what's normal for you and will be able to tell when something's different. If you notice anything unusual, contact your physician.

What happens if cancer is detected?

If cancer is suspected, your physician will perform an ultrasound to confirm it. If the ultrasound appears suspicious, blood will be drawn to test for tumor markers to "stage" the cancer and determine how far it has progressed. You will need a CT scan of your chest, abdomen and pelvis for staging purposes. If you're of child-bearing age, your doctor may recommend that you bank your sperm in case you wish to have children in the future, as some treatment options may affect fertility.

To treat testicle cancer, a surgeon will remove the affected testicle and implant a prosthetic silicon testicle, if desired. Your doctor also may recommend further treatment, such as chemotherapy, radiation or additional surgery.

Luckily, a testicular cancer diagnosis doesn't always equal infertility. I treated a patient in his late 20s who was diagnosed with testicular cancer a few months before his wedding. He had surgery to remove the testicle and had a prosthetic one implanted. He enjoyed his wedding and honeymoon, and began chemotherapy when he returned. Fast forward a few years, and he and his wife have two children. He has routine X-rays to check for recurrence but has been disease-free since finishing treatment. He banked sperm just in case, but by all measures is living a "normal" life.

Launch your own offensive against testicular cancer by making self-exams part of your regular routine.

No Stigma Network Young Woman Gets Her Life Back!

Jennifer Meli was your typical high school student. You wouldn't know it by looking at her that she had any kind of problem, but just four years prior, at seventeen years old, she was diagnosed with severe depression, anxiety, and panic disorder. Her struggle and journey with mental illness stemmed from her childhood and progressively got worse as she got older.

When Jenn was eleven, she and her family moved to Manalapan. Soon after their move, Jenn started to become very self-conscious. She hated the way she looked and she refused to go out and be seen in public. She kept her feelings to herself instead of sharing them with her parents or her friends. This continued into her high school years. In order to feel better about herself, she worked extremely hard to get good grades. She was on the honor roll every marking period. Her teachers loved her. She didn't want her peers to see her as the overweight girl, but as a smart and beautiful young woman.



Although she came off as very shy and timid, Jenn was totally different around her friends and her family. She was always cracking jokes and laughing. She wanted to create the appearance of a perfect life, of which she really wasn't living. When she was 16, she lost a loving uncle. His death came as a horrible shock to the whole family and contributed to the spiraling depression that she was about to fall into.

During a Health Education class, Jenn fainted. The topic was about AIDS and HIV. She started to feel light-headed, nauseous, and sweaty. She had always had a phobia of blood but thought it was normal to experience those kinds of symptoms. When she got up to leave class, everything went black.

After that incident, she couldn't shake the feeling that she was going to faint again. No matter what she did to occupy her mind, she always thought about it until it came to the point where she wasn't able to stay in school for a full day. She started to experience daily panic attacks with body weakness, chest pains, cold sweats, heart palpitations, and loss of breath. Her depression worsened and she had a difficult time accomplishing the daily tasks of showering, sleeping, eating, and going out. She would cry constantly, often staying in bed all day. While her friends were enjoying their senior year of high school, Jenn was at home struggling just to live. After consulting with a psychiatrist, she was prescribed antidepressant medication, and she felt like she had no hope.

Her mom fought hard to get Jenn the help she desperately needed, especially after Jenn told her parents that she wanted to end her life. Scared and upset, her mom called Mobile Response, a service that helps children who are experiencing an emotional or behavioral crisis. One of the responders who came to the house told them about Shrabanee Shah and her peer support organization for young adults called, No Stigma Network (NSN).

Shortly after, Jenn and her mom met with Shrabanee. Through Shrabanee's motivation, support, and encouragement, Jen has learned that she can and will overcome her mental illness. Being involved with NSN has encouraged her to have a positive outlook on life and never to give up. With their help and support, she was able to graduate from high school, find employment, and enroll in college. This coming May, she will have earned an Associate's Degree from Brookdale Community College. Jenn currently works as an administrative assistant and as a substitute paraprofessional. In September 2018, she will continue on her journey to become a Special Education teacher at Georgian Court University.

"In my lifetime I hope to help individuals who suffer with a mental illness, just as Shrabanee encouraged and helped me. I am currently an active member of No Stigma Network's support group, the board of directors, and several committees. I was able to lay the foundation for NSN's first website, which I continue to maintain and update regularly. I also manage NSN's Facebook page. I have spoken in public about my personal story and about NSN. I am always glad to speak to new NSN members about my experiences and how participating in NSN's programs has strengthened and empowered me," Jenn stated.

"I suffer from anxiety, depression, and panic attacks, but these conditions do not define me. My life is mine, and my existence is as valid as that of any other person." Jenn's story is one of success where she learned how to control her deepest anxieties. If you are struggling with the same anxieties, symptoms and thoughts of suicide do yourself a favor and tell someone; a teacher, a parent, a professional. Your life is worth saving. With the proper help, things can only get better.

Mobile Response and Stabilization Services are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week, to help children and youth who are experiencing emotional or behavioral crises. The services are designed to defuse an immediate crisis, keep children and their families' safe, and maintain the children in their own homes or current living situation (such as a foster home, treatment home or group home) in the community. ow Calorie Spinach Pie


Everyone is sure to enjoy this special Greek recipe. The flaky crust and gooey cheese is great for a main dish, side dish or appetizer. To top it all off, it takes just 15 minutes to prepare!

Ingredients:

- 18 servings cooking spray, or enough to coat pan and dough
- 2 tsp olive oil
- 4 (10-ounce) packages chopped frozen spinach, thawed and squeezed to remove excess water
- 1 cup onions, finely chopped
- 2 tbsp. parsley, fresh, chopped
- 1/8 tsp ground nutmeg

- 8 oz. egg whites (8 egg whites)
- 4 oz. feta cheese, crumbled
- 1 tbsp. grated Parmesan cheese

- 1-pound frozen phyllo dough, thawed according to package directions





- 1. Coat a 9 x 13-inch baking pan with cooking spray.
- 2. Heat oil in a large nonstick skillet over medium-high heat. Add spinach and onion and cook until liquid is absorbed, about 5 to 7 minutes; stir in parsley and nutmeg. Remove from heat and transfer mixture to a large bowl. Add egg whites, cheeses and salt and pepper; mix well.
- 3. Lay 1 sheet of phyllo in and up the sides of prepared pan; coat surface lightly with cooking spray. Top with 7 more sheets of phyllo, coating each layer with cooking spray. Spread spinach mixture over dough and top with 8 more sheets of dough, coating each layer with cooking spray. Roll the overhanging sides of dough into the edges of pan, forming a border.
- 4. Using a sharp knife, cut into 8 squares, almost through to the bottom, but not quite or the filling will leak. Refrigerate for 30 minutes.
- 5. Preheat oven to 375 F. Bake until crisp and golden, about 45 minutes. Let stand 5 minutes before cutting squares all the way through to the bottom.



The Best Way to Prevent Apples and Pears from Browning

Emptying your children's lunch boxes at the end of the day and you notice they brought home their apple slices, once again. We've all been there. No matter what you do you cannot seem to figure out how to keep your child's fruit from browning. What type of kid wants brown apples? Please, what adult wants brown apples? As soon as the apple is cut into or injured it is exposed to oxygen. Then enzymes in the fruit, immediately reacts with the oxygen and the cofactor, causing a discoloration of the

Trial and error over a considerable amount of years have lead mothers to some tricks to keeping fruit fresh.

- 1. Slice the fruit in water: by doing this, the inside of the apple is never exposed to the air, therefore it stops the enzyme reaction before it even starts
- 2. Dip the fruit in juice: lemon juice, orange juice, even apple juice. The citric acid will slow down the reaction. Mixing the juice with cold water will prevent the fruit from tasting funny. Also, using apple juice, it is not as acidic but the fruit won't end up tasting like lemons.
- Soak cut fruit in soda: ginger ale or sprite work the same as the fruit juice. This technique won't alter the taste of the fruit, just must be careful of the extra sugar!
- Soak fruit in acid powder: In a bowl, mix fruit-fresh or citric acid powder with cold water
- 5. Soak fruit in salt water.
- **6.** Use a rubber band: the newest trick moms have been using is to slice the apple then place it back together using a rubber band to hold it in

THE BUYER'S SIDE **OF A REAL ESTATE TRANSACTION**

The first step in a New Jersey residential real estate transaction is the signing of the contract. When a realtor is involved, a buyer may sign the contract prepared by the realtor and then immediately have it sent to their attorney for review. Both attorneys will then discuss the terms of the contract and make appropriate changes as required. However, it is important that a buyer ensure that the realtor prepared contract is immediately forwarded to their attorney because there is a three day deadline for the attorney review period.

One concern for a buyer is how and where they are going to get the money to purchase the home. Typically, buyers will obtain their purchase money either from the sale of their existing home, a mortgage, or a combination of both. If a buyer has an existing home to sell, it is important that there is a "home to sell" contingency in their purchase contract. This means that they will not be obligated to buy the new home until their existing home is sold and they have the money from that sale. Further, it is important that any purchase contract is contingent upon the buyer actually obtaining a mortgage. Without these contingencies, a buyer can be in breach of contract if they are unable to close on the new home because they do not yet have the proceeds of the sale of their existing home or were unable to get a mortgage.

Another issue that buyers must be concerned with is the home inspection. Typically, buyers will have between 10 and 14 days from the date of the contract to have a qualified home inspector perform an inspection on the home. The home inspectors generally look for system failures (i.e.-air conditioning systems, heating systems, hot water heaters, septic systems, wells, etc.). However, they also look for potential hidden defects that could signal the existence of a bigger problem such as past or present roof leaks, water infiltration, structural defects, termites, mold or the existence of underground oil tanks. Depending upon the severity of the issues found, the buyers may be able to obtain a credit or a reduction of the sale price or, alternatively, request that the sellers repair or replace the defective items prior to the time of closing.

Finally, prior to entering into a contract, buyers must be aware of the actual amount of money they will need to close. Although the buyers may have enough money to cover the purchase price of the home, they must also take into account closing fees that must be paid at the time of closing. These include title and title insurance costs, mortgage company charges, escrows for taxes and insurance, capital contributions to homeowners' associations, surveys and attorney's fees. In an average residential real estate transaction, I typically tell my clients that they should at least have an additional \$10,000.00 available for these closing costs in order to be on the safe side. However, this is just a guidepost and may differ in each transaction depending upon the cost of the home and issues involved.

Of course, the purchase of a home is the biggest single transaction and investment that people make during the course of their lifetime. Accordingly, it is important to obtain the right attorney to insure that all of their interests are protected and the above issues are properly addressed.

Enjoy a long retirement with multiple income streams

Increasing longevity is a practical reason you may want to develop an income plan to cover your expenses. To help you enjoy a long and comfortable retirement, using many different types of income streams can help balance your need for both growth and income while providing options to help minimize taxes throughout your retirement.

Retirement accounts — Your IRA and your employer-sponsored retirement plan, such as a 401(k), can be essential sources of retirement income. Distributions from a traditional IRA or employer-sponsored plan are taxable, and distributions from a Roth IRA or employer-sponsored plan are tax-free. Social Security benefits — Although the rules have recently changed, the best way to maximize Social Security benefits may still be to wait as long as possible before taking benefits, especially for the higher-earning spouse. You can start receiving benefits at age 62; however, benefits received before your "full" retirement age (currently age 66 or 67) will be permanently reduced. If you delay taking benefits past full retirement age, the amount you receive will increase every year until age 70.

Annuity income — Annuities are insurance company products that may help assure a predictable lifetime income. Similar to creating a "personal pension," they come in a variety of forms and can provide a guaranteed income stream for as long as you live, no matter what happens in the markets. Read the prospectus carefully to understand the objectives, risks, charges and expenses before investing in an annuity.

Reverse mortgage equity — While a reverse mortgage is not suitable for everyone, for those needing to tap the equity in their homes, it can be something to think about. A reverse mortgage can either provide you with additional regular income payments or be used as a strategy during down markets when withdrawals from your portfolio may be unfavorable.

By taking full advantage of these sources of income, you can go a long way toward enjoying the retirement you have envisioned. So plan ahead, learn all your options and make those choices that are right for you.

Thicker Hair

A full head of thick, healthy hair is something everyone wants to have and keep as they get older. As we age though, it is harder to keep our hair looking as soft and beautiful as it once did. 

Lesser-known signs of cancer you shouldn't ignore

A constant headache that a Tylenol can't remedy, unexplained lower back or rib pain, or a nagging cough that won't quit, may not simply be signs of anxiety, stress or a cold or flu, but may indicate a more serious health concern—cancer.



"May is Better Hearing & Speech Month (BHSM)", recognizing that 1 in 5 Americans have some sort of hearing loss."



It is certainly alarming, as we watch the next generation of Americans pump up the music on the latest set of wireless ear buds. As audiologists, this is deeply concerning because music companies encourage children and teens to "experience the music" at loud volumes.

I, too, am guilty of blasting music and attending a concert or two that left my ears ringing for days. But as a member of the New Jersey Speech-Language-Hearing Association, I feel compelled to note that once someone loses their hearing, he or she can't get it back.

Just look at all the rock stars who are now suffering from permanent hearing loss, from Pete Townsend, to Eric Clapton, to Paul Stanley to Brian Wilson. Many of these musicians are now learning to lip-read after suffering from hearing loss and tinnitus. Tinnitus occurs when the ear perceives sound, often in the form of ringing, even when no sound is present.

When a child or teen blasts music through ear buds, it goes straight into their ears. The levels of the music they experience can be as damaging as attending concerts and can result in hearing loss and ringing in the ears. We must educate parents, teachers and children about how these earbuds can contribute to permanent hearing loss.



STOP SUFFERING IN SILENCE:

11 Truths About Menopause

For years women didn't talk much about the changes they experienced before, during and after menopause. It's just in the last 30 years or so that women have been encouraged to speak with their physicians about their symptoms. Now, women are much more in tune with their bodies and proactive about seeking treatment for the symptoms that can make life uncomfortable.

Here are 11 lesser-known facts about "the change of life."

- 1. Menopause is diagnosed after it's over.
- The pre-cursor to menopause is peri-menopause.
- Menopause is more than just hot flashes.
- Hot flashes can affect your focus.
- 5. Menopause can start as early as 40 years of age.
- Menopause can start as late as your early 60s.
- There are several treatments for hot flashes, not just hormone therapy.
- There's no correlation between when your period starts and when you start
- The amount of calcium in your bones is set at age 30.
- 10. Not all women need both estrogen and progesterone after menopause.
- 11. There are several options to relieve vaginal dryness.

The most important advice I can give women is that there are a variety of effective treatments to manage the symptoms of menopause. There is no reason to suffer. Talk to your doctor about your options.

When your body stops producing estrogen, one side effect is vaginal dryness, which can make intercourse uncomfortable. Estrogen therapy can help. If you have other menopausal symptoms, your doctor may recommend oral hormone replacement. However, if your only symptom is dryness, a topical, low-dose estrogen treatment may be more appropriate. Topical estrogen comes in several forms: cream, tablet or vaginal ring. Your doctor should prescribe the lowest dose of estrogen needed to relieve dryness. Vaginal moisturizers also can be used, as well as some newer, non-hormonal FDA-approved therapies. The FDA-cleared fractional CO2 laser has been a promising new non-medication treatment as well.

A recent patient had been suffering from vaginal dryness – and painful intercourse – for nearly three years before she booked an appointment with me for guidance. Her previous ob/gyn hadn't asked about vaginal dryness during her well-woman visit and she was embarrassed to bring it up herself. We had a frank discussion about her symptoms and after an examination, I prescribed a topical vaginal treatment. Her symptoms improved significantly at her two-month follow up visit and continued so she was able to be intimate with her partner again.

The most important advice I can give women is that there are a variety of effective treatments to manage the symptoms of menopause. There is no reason to suffer. Talk to your doctor about your options.

Weekend Getaways Delaware Water Gap History and Delaware Water Gap National Recreational Area By Pam Teel

The Delaware Water Gap is a water gap on the border of New Jersey and Pennsylvania where the Delaware River cuts through a large ridge of the Appalachian Mountains. The gap constitutes the southern portion of the Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area, which is used primarily for recreational purposes, such as rafting, canoeing, swimming, fishing, hiking, and rock climbing.

A water gap is a geological feature where a river cuts through a mountain ridge. The Delaware Water Gap began to form 500 million years ago when quartz pebbles from mountains in the area were deposited in a shallow sea. The Martinsburg Shale on the eastern side of what was to be Kittatinny Mountain was uplifted 450 million years ago when a chain of volcanic islands collided with proto-North America. These islands slid over the North American plate, and deposited rock on top of plate, forming the Highlands and Kittatinny Valley.

About 400 million years ago, a small, narrow continent collided with proto-North America. The heat from the pressure melted the quartzite, which allowed it to bend the quartz pebbles and Silurian Shawangunk Conglomerate. This layer was then uplifted and cracked over thousands of years. During this period, the Delaware River slowly cut its path down through the shattered and cracked quartzite. If the quartzite had not been cracked, the river would not have been able to cut its path through the mountain to form the gap.

The ridge of the Appalachians that the Delaware crosses is called the Blue Mountains in Pennsylvania and the Kittatinny Ridge in New Jersey. This is the first major ridge of the Appalachian Mountains. The New Jersey mountain is called Mount Tammany, named after the Native American Chief Tamanend. The Pennsylvania Mountain is Mount Minsi, named after the Native American tribe of the area. The summit of Tammany is 1,540 ft (470 m) above sea level.

There are two visitor centers, one in New Jersey near the Delaware River Bridge and the other in Dingmans' Ferry, Pennsylvania. The Headquarters is located on River Road in Pennsylvania. The New Jersey side of the gap is also protected within Worthington State Forest, a New Jersey State Forest wholly contained within the recreation area.

Hiking trails

The Red Dot Trail, NJ, is a path to the top of the Kittatinny Ridge, which has views of the entire area. This is roughly a one-hour hike, traversing over 600 vertical feet. The red dot trail is highly eroded due to weather and large numbers of hikers. The Gray Dot Trail is a very steep climber's trail that goes from I-80 to the top of the gap along the top edge of the big wall. The trail has shale and rocks, which make hiking very difficult. This trail intersects with the blue dot and red dot trail at the top. The hike up the gray dot trail and down the red dot trail takes about two hours and fifteen minutes. The blue dot also goes to the top, but is about a 3-mile hike that is less steep than the red dot. The Red Dot Trail is just one of two trails that lead to the outstanding view looking into the Delaware Water Gap from Mt. Tammany. Combining the Red Dot Trail with the Blue Blaze Trail makes a three-mile loop trail. If making a loop hike, consider hiking up the Red Dot Trail and down the Blue Blaze Trail, because most people find it easier to hike up the Red Dot Trail, rather than down the trail.

Over twenty miles of trail can be connected together in the Worthington State Forest area to fill the entire day. It's one heck of a climb but the two views are worth it! The Mohegan Outdoor Education Center has trails that are part of this recreation area as well, which is also combined with trails in the Worthington State Park. The NJ side has the rugged part, while the PA part has the charming town by rt. 611.

The Appalachian Trail crosses the Delaware River on the Route 80 Bridge and goes up Dunnfield Creek to Sunfish Pond and continues northeast

to Stokes State Forest. The trail crosses Route 206 and continues along the top of Kittatinny Mountain to High Point State Park where the trail turns east and eventually goes into New York State. This part of the Appalachian Trail is maintained by the New York - New Jersey Trail Conference hiking club.

Rock climbing

The Gap is a popular place to rock-climb in New Jersey. The climbs are one hundred fifty to three hundred feet (46 to 91 meters), climbing on Silurian Shawagunk conglomerate, which is quartzite, with bands of shale from a half inch to four inches thick. Most climbing is done on the New Jersey side due to easier access. There are about one hundred climbs on the New Jersey side. Climbers follow the gray dot trail along route 80, then passing the large rock face on route 80. They then go up the path to the route they choose.





Meningitis at College

Did you know between 100 and 125 cases occur on college campuses every year?

- 5 to 15 college students die each year as a result.
- Cases among teenagers and young adults have more than doubled since 1991.
- The frequency of outbreaks has risen at U.S. colleges and universities during the 1990's.

What is meningitis? Meningitis is a rare but potentially fatal bacterial infection.

- It can occur in two forms, as either meningococcal meningitis, an inflammation that affects the brain and spinal cord, or as meningococcemia, the presence of bacteria in the blood.
- Permanent brain damage, hearing loss, learning disability, limb amputation, kidney failure, or death can result from the infections.

Is there a vaccine to help prevent meningitis? A safe, effective vaccine is available.

- The vaccine is safe, with mild and infrequent side effects, such as redness and pain at the injection site lasting up to 2 days.
- After vaccination, immunity develops within 7 to 10 days and remains effective for approximately 3 to 5 years. As with any vaccine, vaccinations against meningitis may not protect 100% of all susceptible individuals.

Is vaccination recommended for college students?

Certain college students, particularly freshmen who live or plan to live in dormitories or residence halls, have a 6-fold increased risk of disease.

• The American College Health Association (ACHA) has adopted

the recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), which starts that college students, particularly freshmen living in dormitories and residence halls, be educated about meningococcal meningitis and the potential benefits of vaccination.

• Other undergraduate students wishing to reduce their risk of meningitis can also choose to be vaccinated.

Early symptoms of meningitis:

- high fever
- rash
- vomiting
- severe headache
- neck stiffness
- lethargy
- nausea
- sensitivity to light
- Meningitis usually peaks in late winter and early spring, overlapping flu season, and symptoms can easily be mistaken for the flu.
- Because the infection progresses quickly, students should seek medical care immediately if 2 or more of these symptoms occur at one time.

If untreated, meningitis can lead to shock and death within hours of the first symptom. If you have more questions please speak to your trusted physician.






Baby Wipes: Reducing Your Baby's food Allergies

Food allergies occur when your immune system believes that a substance is detrimental to your body causing it to overreact, triggering an allergic reaction. In recent studies, it has been detected that baby wipes could increase the risk of a child developing a food allergy. The synthetic in baby wipes, sodium lauryl sulphate, is also found in soap and has been proven to disrupt the skin's protective fatty barrier. Even if a child has yet to ingest a food item, it may still enter their body through the skin. To reduce this risk, parents and guardians should be more aware. Always be sure to wash your hands before handling your baby, to reduce risk of exposure to unfamiliar food particles. Researchers also suggest rinsing off the area where a wipe was used to decrease the amount of sodium laurel sulphate that is absorbed by the skin.


